



Decorative map of America, including California as an island, a single open Great Lake directly connected to the St. Lawrence River, the Strait of Anian in the northwest and no Mississippi River details north of the Mid-Continent, along with several curious east to west mountain The map illustrated an early account of the New World published by Vander Aa, one of the most prolific compilers of information on the early explorations to America, Asia and Africa.





Pieter van der Aa was a prolific publisher. He published a.o. *Naauwkeurge versameling der gedenkwaardigste zee-en land-reysen*, a series of accounts of voyages (1706-08) and *Galorie agruable du monde*, completed in 1729. An attractive world map in Mercator's projection, showing the circumnavigation of Francis Drake. Embellished with a decorative title-cartouche.
